Key Elements of the 2025 Leaders for Geelong Program

ELEMENT	DESCRIPTION
Opening Retreat	A two-day event that sets the scene for the year, focusing on building relationships with peers and local leaders whilst engaging with the Geelong region to understand its needs, challenges, and opportunities for impactful leadership.
Strengths Profile	The Strengths Profile is an online assessment that will provide detailed insights into realised and unrealised strengths, learnt behaviours and weaknesses. This includes a 1.5 hour debrief.
3 x Building Blocks Days	Dedicated days focused on leadership mindsets, knowledge, skills and behaviours, with opportunities to practice in a safe environment.
4 x Community Days	In person events focused on learning from local leaders and engaging with the Geelong region to understand its needs, challenges, and opportunities for impactful leadership.
9 x Masterclasses	Monthly masterclasses offer opportunities to connect with peers, reflect on your learning journey, and explore topics of interest to the cohort.
6 Month Community Project	A six-month collaborative project where participants work with a local organisation to address a specific community issue and drive meaningful change. The project culminates in a major event, where project teams present their project to a large audience of local leaders.
State Parliament Melbourne Visit	A visit to the State Parliament in Melbourne to broaden your understanding of the structures and processes of the Victorian Parliament and experience Parliament in action.
Federal Parliament Canberra Visit	A two-day trip to Federal Parliament in Canberra to discuss leadership with key political and government leaders and gain an insight into how Australia's political and decision-making system works – past, present and future.
Graduation	The culminating event celebrating the completion of the Leaders for Geelong Program, recognising participants' achievements and development throughout the year.
